

Mini Physical AND Driver's License Examination Policy

<u>PIAA</u>
(Parent Initials) Many organizations like the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Associations (PIAA) require a physical examination within three or sometimes six months prior to filling out a health authorization form.
<u>Driver's License</u>
(Parent Initials) The PA form says the following: "THIS FORM IS VALID FOR 1 YEAR FROM THE DATE OF PHYSICAL EXAMINATION. The physical date may not be more than 6 months prior to your 16th birthday. "
Most insurance companies will not pay for these additional exams and will insist that we pass the cost on to families if we submit the claims, as we do with all other visits to our office. This cost is typically over \$100.
Center City Pediatrics now has a more convenient and affordable alternative—a <i>Mini-Physical Visit</i> . This type of visit includes an exam, specific to the form's requirements, and completion of the form. The cost for this service is \$50 which includes the \$10 form fee, based on a normal exam. If there are abnormal findings, by law, these diagnoses must be reported to your insurance company. This could result in a deductible, co-insurance or copay that may be required per your specific insurance policy. You will receive a bill from our office for this visit.
